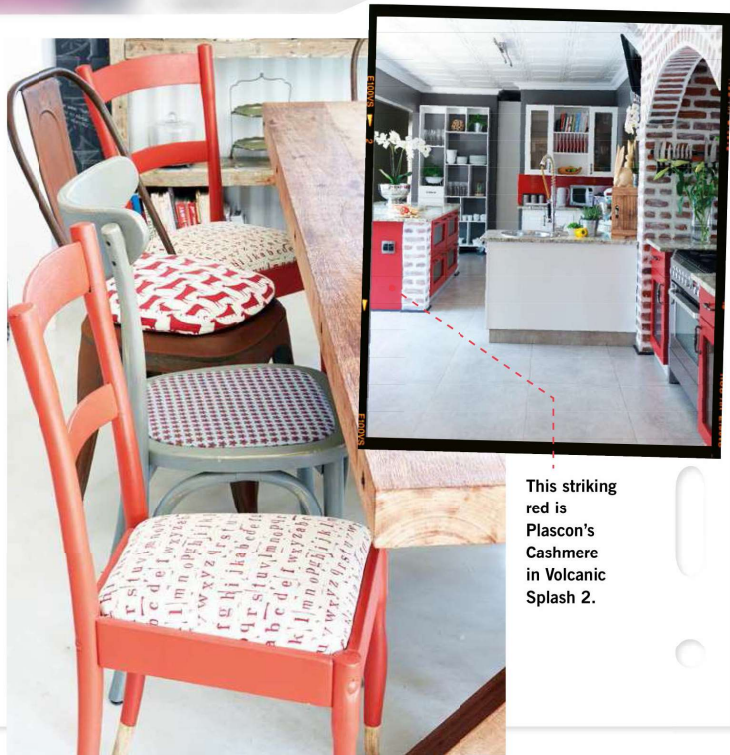


**Red alert!**

I'm looking for the red chairs featured on page 42 of your January 2016 issue and the red paint on page 76 of *Home Renovations* 2015. I'd like to paint my stoep; what would you recommend?

The homeowner purchased the classic red Globe chairs at Kim's Corner (043 722 6319) in East London. Take a look at second-hand stores and on Gumtree or OLX. I've also seen similar ones at Vamp (021 448 2755, [vampfurniture.blogspot.com](http://vampfurniture.blogspot.com)) in Cape Town; they're always willing to find specific pieces for you.

The red paint used in the kitchen is Plascon Cashmere in Volcanic Splash 2, but I wouldn't recommend it for a stoep. Unfortunately, paint products specifically designed for stoeps, such as Plascon Stoep Enamel and Medal Stoep Paint, are only available in a limited variety of colours.
